Stage 2 & 3 INTERHOUSE SWIMMING CARNIVAL – Wednesday 19 February

The Junior School Swimming Carnival for Stage 2&3 will be held on Wednesday 19 February at the <u>Logan</u> <u>North Aquatic Centre</u>. Please read carefully over this letter and the information included.

Transport: Students will travel by bus to and from the pool. They are scheduled to leave the College at

8:50am. We ask that families have their children at the college by 8:30am for this event. The

bus will return by the end of the College Day.

Uniform: Students are to wear their College House Uniform (House shirt and PE shorts) over their togs, to

and from the Aquatic Centre. **All students** should wear conservative swim attire and be sun smart. Girls who only have a two-piece (bikini style) swimsuit will be expected to wear a shirt/rashie when swimming, as well as shorts if the 'bikini bottoms' are not appropriate for a school carnival. A one-piece swimsuit is the preferred option for girls who are swimming competitively. Students are to take **a hat, rashie, swimming cap, towel, sunscreen, water bottle, lunch and goggles (optional)**. College Swimming Caps can be purchased from the College

Reception.

Events: Students will swim in age groups depending on their birth year. Students will select their swim

strokes in class time from either the Championship Division or the Intermediate Division based on their ability. Swimming aids are available as needed for intermediate swimmers. Championship Division events are allocated a higher number of points according to the position they finish. It is recommended that students who are considering competing for Age

Champion participate in the Championship Division events.
