



CALVARY BASKETBALL 2025

Calvary is once again offering Basketball in the Middle and Senior School. Last year saw our program grow significantly, thanks to the amazing work of Ps Adam Low and Ps Phil Power.

Training will start in the third week back (10 February) on Monday afternoons, from 3.35-4.45pm on the MPC. At the end of training sessions, parents are to pick up their students from the MPC carpark only, so that staff know that the players have been safely collected. If parents are unable to arrive by this time then the student should not attend the session.

The major competitions for the year will be the Rivers Championships across Terms 1 and 2, and the CSSAQ and Elite 8 Tournaments in Term 3. We are also endeavoring to arrange some Friendly matches/competitions across the year. Details of each of these will come out in separate letters.

The cost to be involved in the Basketball program is \$60 per semester (\$50 for an additional child), which includes all competition entry fees (team and individual), bus transport and training/equipment expenses. This amount will be invoiced to parents once students join the program and is non-refundable if a student leaves the program. This amount needs to be paid before their first competition.

The Basketball uniform is to be worn for all games and for training sessions. This year students have the option of purchasing either brand new uniforms or some second-hand uniforms that have been borrowed out to players in previous years. The new uniforms cost \$35 per garment (shorts and singlet), and the second-hand uniforms cost \$15 per garment. Please contact me if you need any of the above. Uniforms can be paid at the office (EFTPOS) prior to collection, or in cash at the point of collection.
