CAPA (Creative and Performing Arts) Category

CAPA Service Awards	Gold, Silver and Bronze commendations are presented to students in Stage 3. These are based on the duration of students' active participation in the CAPA Program.
Most Improved and Emerging Leader Awards	Recognising students' achievement in various Ensembles, Bands and Choirs.
Junior Performing Arts Award	Recognising musical excellence, commitment and contribution to Calvary's Creative and Performing Arts program.

Sport Category

Sports Awards	Gold, Silver and Bronze Sport commendations are presented to students in Stage 2 and 3. These are based on students' achievement and level of participation in a variety of Interhouse, Interschool and Queensland School Sports competitions and carnivals across the year.
Player of the Year and Spirit Awards	• Recognising significant student achievements in Team sports such as Netball, Futsal and Volleyball. • State Level Representation.
Sportswoman and Sportsman of the Year	Recognising those who have represented Calvary at the highest level and have made the greatest contribution to sport during the year.

Service Learning	Service Learning awards are presented to one student per class in Prep – Stage 3, who demonstrate commitment to engaging in or initiating service opportunities that add value to the lives of others in our community.
Personal Growth	Personal Growth awards are presented to one student per class in Prep – Stage 3, who demonstrate a commitment to personal transformation in an area of their life.
Skills Development	Skills Development awards are presented to one student per class from Prep – Stage 3 who demonstrate personal commitment to developing the Learning Habits skills.

Academic Achievement	• Academic Achievement Awards are presented to our highest achieving students in Stage 2 (Year 3 and Year 4) who have achieved academic excellence within their cohort. • Dux and Proxime Accessit Awards are presented to our highest achieving Stage 3 (Year 5 and 6) students.
Academic Growth	Academic Growth Awards are presented to one student per class, Prep – Stage 3, who has demonstrated substantial academic growth and effort throughout the year.
