CALVARY BASKETBALL 2026

Calvary is once again offering Basketball in the Middle and Senior School. Last year saw our program grow significantly, thanks to the amazing work of Ps Adam Low and Ps Phil Power.

Training will start in the second week back (2 February) on Monday afternoons, from 3.35-4.45pm on the MPC. Students are to wear their Basketball uniform or their sports uniform to all training sessions. At the end of training sessions, parents are to pick up their students from the MPC carpark only, so that staff know that the players have been safely collected. If parents are unable to arrive by this time then the student should not attend the session.

The major competitions for the year will be the Rivers Championships across Terms 1 and 2, and the CSSAQ and Peak Jam Tournaments in Term 3. We are also endeavoring to arrange some Friendly matches/competitions across the year. Details of each of these will come out in separate letters.

There is no initial cost to join the program and attend training sessions. Once competitions start, selected students will be charged a nominated amount per event through our Consent2Go platform (when parent permission is given to attend). This fee will contribute towards registration fees and bus costs of the competition.

The Basketball uniform is to be worn for all games/competitions. The uniform cost \$35 per garment (shorts are \$35 and the singlet is \$35). Uniforms can be paid at the office (EFTPOS) prior to collection, or in cash at the point of collection.
