



COLLEGE FREE DRESS GUIDELINES

- Shorts should reach to just above the knees and cannot be shorter than mid-thigh (measured by students hand placed at their side).
- Students may not colour their hair except as in the College Uniform Policy.
- Student Jewellery is required to meet the expectations of the College Uniform Policy (this includes but is not limited to earrings and necklaces).
- Students may not wear make-up, false-eye lashes or mascara.
- Stomach regions should not be exposed.
- Students should wear a t-shirt or equivalent. No bare midriffs, low necklines, singlets or strappy tops.
- Students must wear respectable tops (clothing that has negative or inappropriate slogans or images will not be permitted).
- Practical closed shoes to be worn that do not impede the ability of students to
 participate in class or scheduled activities (no crocs or thongs are allowed).
- Leggings, tights and other such athletic apparel are not appropriate for free dress days.

Please note that students arriving inappropriately dressed will be asked to wait at the main reception to either be taken home or have appropriate clothes delivered.
