23<sup>RD</sup> & 24<sup>TH</sup> May - QLD Super Series event (Logan Metro Centre, Crestmead) 20<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> June - QLD State Championships (Nissan Arena, Nathan) 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> August - Future Champions Cup (Nissan Arena, Nathan) 29<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup> August - National Championships (for those that qualify only) - Gold Coast Sport & Leisure centre, Carrara. (Please note: spectators are required to purchase tickets for entry at most competitions which can range from \$8 - \$15).

# COMPETITION SEASON PACKAGE COST – (finishing 11<sup>th</sup> September 2025)

All children, regardless of National qualification will continue to train until September 2025. In the event that children do not qualify for the National Championships, they will continue to work on strength, fitness, and technique.

#### REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

Registration and payment are strictly online and a link for payment will be sent to you once your child is registered. The registration and payment must be completed prior to your child participating in the program. Once the season has commenced there will be no refunds issued.

#### **OTHER ASSOCIATED COSTS COSTUME**

- Competition team costume, leotard (1 only for the year and will remain as the leotard for ongoing years) Further information will be given prior to these being needed to be purchased. The approximate cost is \$80.

#### NATIONAL CHAMPIONSHIPS

If teams qualify for the National Championship event in September, the following extra costs will apply:

- National Championship entry fee of \$50 per child.
- <u>Compulsory</u> video & photography levy (supplies all students with digital footage of their routines at Nationals as well as access to all professional photos taken of their performance) \$25.

\*This cost will be due upon entry into the National event in July, and payment will be collected directly by Industrie1 coordinators. FISAF enforces strict entry deadlines, team members who have not accepted their position and made payment by the due date will not be entered.

#### **COMPETITION TEAM EXPECTATIONS**

Please ensure your child understands the commitment they are making to their team and their training sessions. If your child commits to a team, they are committing to that teams set training sessions. Teams <u>cannot compete</u> if they do not have the required number of competitors, so competition attendance is vital. Please consider the cost and commitment before registering. We would like to assign teams and commence training as soon as possible and withdrawals can be very disruptive to teams that have already commenced training.
