We have been busy learning, practising and refining our celebration performances and we are all excited to perform for you. Please see below for important details about this event.

Parking

Please be mindful of the signage and neighbours' driveways if parking along Dennis Rd or any side street. The best parking is at Real Life Christian Church, a short walk through the school to the lower oval for the event.

Arrival

All students and families, please arrive by **5:30pm** to the lower oval. A parent must attend the event with their child.

Prep and Stage 1 students as well as Piccolo and Voices choir students are to be dropped off at the grandstand.

All other Stage 2 and 3 students will sit with their families to watch the P-2 items.

The Celebration service begins at 6pm. Teachers will supervise Prep and Stage 1 up until Intermission.

Pick Up

At Intermission, (around 6:45pm), all Prep and Stage 1 students will be collected by parents from the grandstand. Families may choose to leave during the Intermission or are welcome to stay for the Stage 2 and 3 performances. Stage 2 and 3 students need to assemble at the grandstand.

Celebration should conclude around 7:30pm when all Stage 2 and 3 students can be picked up from the grandstand.

These will be handed out in named zip lock bags to your child after our undercover area rehearsal on Wednesday 26 November.
